Bethany Park, a public park at the "heart" of the Central Avenue District, is one of many core parks in Wyandotte County, covering a total of 8.4 acres. Within a half-mile radius, this park has the potential to serve the local residents and the community, providing new amenities and outdoor activity capabilities. In tandem with its connection to the Bethany Community Center, this park could become the outdoor/recreation hub for Wyandotte County.

The most successful existing assets of the park, are the recreation center building, the two night-lit futsal courts, and the annual "La Placita" events that began in 2014. Currently, the park has pathways that lead to and from the entry of the recreation center, but does not offer a walking/jogging loop for its users. Additionally, there is an existing playground, however the play equipment is poorly maintained, and many consider it unfit for children. The sloping of the park away from the street, in combination with poor morning/evening lighting, makes activities happening in the park difficult to see, causing many residents to feel unsafe. Research surveys have shown great local interest to improve these conditions, in hopes that Bethany Park can become a safe, fun location for children and families, that will ultimately promote positive, healthy activities throughout the community.
